Entry Fee: \$6 per animal (one fee for both rings) if entry postmarked by August 1, 2011.

Make checks payable to: HOMDGA.

Fees MUST ACCOMPANY entries and be postmarked by August 1, 2011 or arrive by noon that same day or day of show rate will be charged.

Complete Entry: *A complete entry includes 1) proof of insurance as required by Bangor State Fair, 2) The Bangor State Fair Covenant Not To Sue, 3) HOMDGA entry form and 4) show fees. Your entry will be returned if it is not complete. Failure to submit any of these by the deadline will constitute a late entry and day of show rates will apply. Failure to submit any of these forms will forfeit you ability to show at Bangor State Fair.*

SHOW RULES AND GUIDELINES

ADGA Rules shall govern these shows

1. Any animals showing signs of contagious and/or infectious diseases will result in the herd being asked to leave. Animals that become sick during the show will be removed from display pens **and will not be shown.**
2. Entries are accepted from all Maine counties provided the herd is not under quarantine. Health papers are required from all out-of-state animals. Out-of-state exhibitors must obtain a written permit from the Maine State Department of Agriculture, Division of Animal Industry, Augusta, Maine 04333. Permit and health papers may be checked prior to unloading.
3. **No exhibitor will be allowed to unload animals or show without signing the Bangor State Fair Release and Covenant Not to Sue and providing proof of insurance as required by Bangor State Fair.**
4. Original registration papers must be presented on all animals over 6 months of age. All animals under 6 months of age may be shown with a stamped duplicate registration. **A stamped duplicate is only valid for 30 days from date ADGA issues** (new 2010). No copies of registration papers will be accepted. Persons showing animals whose papers have been signed for transfer but have not been processed for transfer by the ADGA office must show those animals as agents for the current owner shown on ADGA records.
5. Base date for age computation is date of show (August 7, 2011)
6. Animals must be shown in their regular class to be eligible to compete in specialty classes. Animals are to be shown in the same breed in the specialty classes as they were in the regular classes. Purebreds and recorded grades may not be combined.
7. There will be no pre-show milk out.
8. Entries are unlimited (except where noted in specialty classes), however **no more than two premiums will be awarded per exhibitor per class per ring.**
9. Substitutions will be allowed within a given breed only.
10. Tattoos must be legible to receive a leg on a championship.
11. Order of judging: Ring 1 Oberhasli, Nubian, Recorded Grade, Lamancha, Alpine, AOP. Ring 2, Nubian, Oberhasli, Lamancha, Recorded Grade, AOP, Alpine. Order is judging may be changed at the discretion of the show committee.
12. The Sunday Senior Doe Shows will begin at 9:00 am followed by the Jr. Doe Shows. Papers will be checked between 8:00 and 9:00 on Sunday morning and on Saturday afternoon.

13. Exhibitors are **required** to be on the fairground by 8:30 am day of show. **Early or late arrivals must be coordinated with the Show Chairperson.** The show committee will assign pens, based on registration entry, according to need and availability. Please do not change pen assignments without consulting a member of the show committee first. **Pens will be available by Saturday 8am.**
14. Tack Pens may or may not be available.
15. Some pens at the fair are not built to keep kids or Nigerian Dwarfs in. Please bring items to fill gaps should you need to.
16. Entry fee refunds will only be given when *entire* herd is scratched and the show secretary is notified no later than 3 days prior to the day of show. Breeders and herds leaving the show before the designated time will forfeit all premiums.
17. Breeders are responsible to follow the general livestock rules as outlined by Bangor State Fair.

Show Guidelines:

1. All exhibitors are requested to wear white in the show ring.
2. Owners of permanent champion animals are requested to show them in the champion challenge class.
3. Please have animals ready and at ringside when breed classes are called.

JUNIOR DOES

CLASS #

- 1 Junior kids under 4 months of age
- 2 Senior kids 4 months and under 8 months of age
- 3 Junior yearlings 8 months and under 12 months of age
- 4 Senior Yearlings 12 months and under 24 months of age

SENIOR DOES

CLASS #

- 5 Milkers under 2 years of age
- 6 Milkers 2 years and under 3 years of age
- 7 Milkers 3 years and under 5 years of age
- 8 Milkers 5 years and older
- 9 Champion Challenge

SPECIALTY CLASSES

CLASS #

- 10 Junior Get of Sire—Three Junior does all with the same sire
- 11 Senior Get of Sire – Three Senior does all with the same sire
- 12 Senior Best 3 Females (to consist of three does in milk—exhibitor owned)—One entry per exhibitor
